



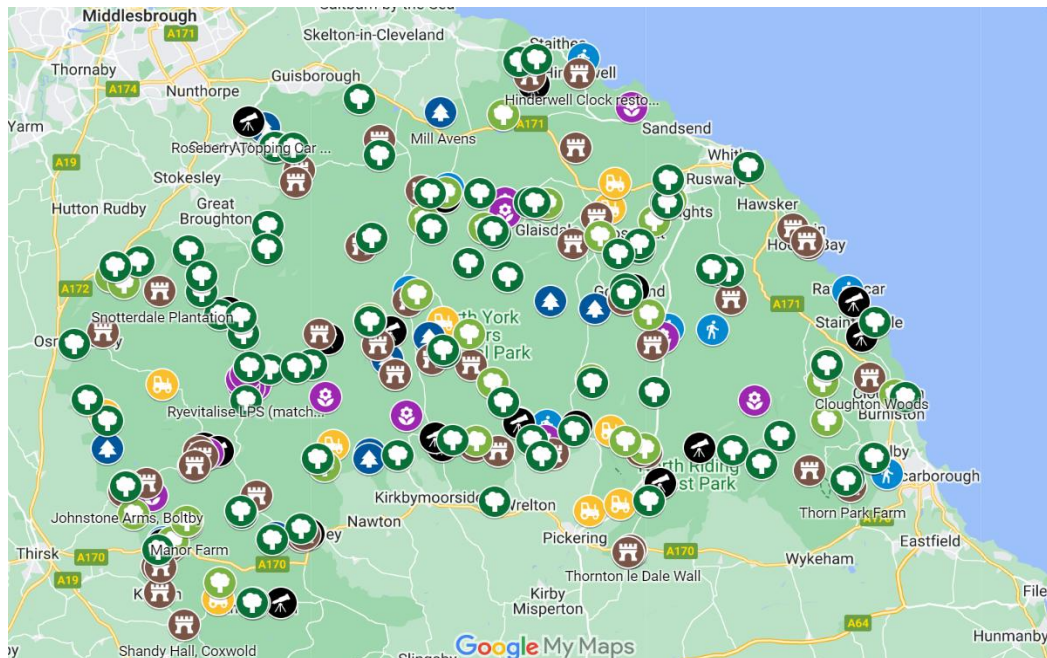

What is the s106 agreement

- Legal agreement that offsets the unmitigated harm of the development on the special qualities of the North York Moors National Park

Woodland Creation projects

- 37,141 trees
- 8 new woodland creation projects totalling 38ha.

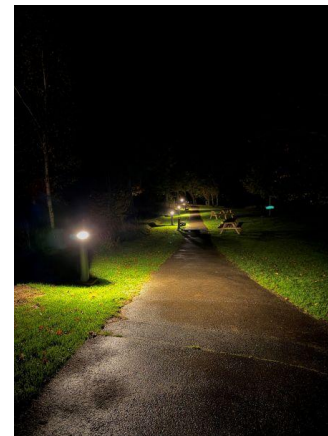

Landscape & Ecology

144 projects delivered in 2025-2026

- Landscape trees 107 @ 5 sites
- Lighting – 8 projects including Danby Lodge, Kevin Ryan racing stables, Spaunton Estate, Lasingham Village Hall and Ampleforth Abbey
- 4 dark sky friendly communities designated
- Golden Plover Tracking Project on Bransdale Moor



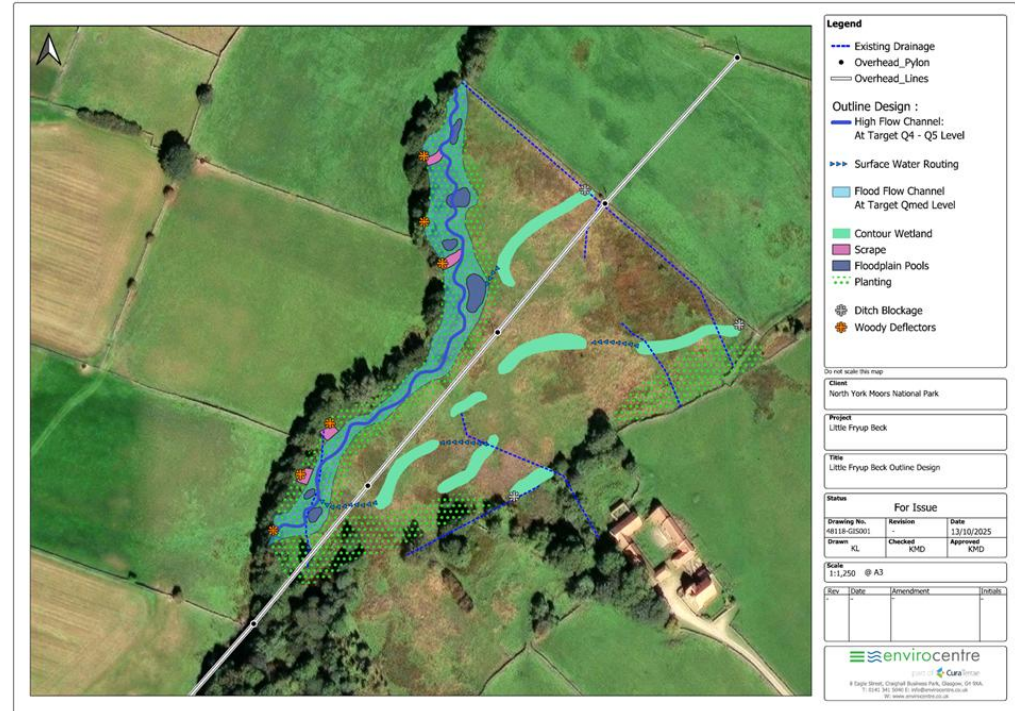
Landscape & Ecology

- North York Moors Biodiversity Conservation Assessment
- 190ha habitat enhancement
- 9 farm advice workshops/ training activities with 132 attendees
- Woodland Management 25ha (Scot Ridge)



Landscape & Ecology

- Creation of habitat masterplan for Little Fryup Beck – one of 21 plans, reports and feasibility studies delivered
- 2940m of boundary enhancements in 13 projects
 - 60% walls
 - 40% hedgerows



Landscape & Ecology

Historic Environment

- Grant scheme supporting projects including:
 - Stonebeckgate Farm collection
 - Repairs to Egton Weir
 - Archaeological investigation at Iron Age site at Wykeham
 - Carbon dating iron age site at Hutton le Hole
- Geophysics survey at Liverton Moor
- Level 2 earthwork survey of Lockton High Moor and Saltergate Moor
- 27 Heritage buildings and 6 heritage assets restored

Access

- Restoring Roseberry Topping
 - Upland path restoration and upland acid grassland restoration Roseberry Topping summit to Summer House Fields – Path 2 – 360m²
 - Woodland path restoration in Newton Woods – Path 4 – 680m²
 - Woodland path restoration in Cliff Ridge Woods – Path 8 – 2,040m²
- 5.84km public rights of way enhancement
- 47 access improvements

Tourism

- Experience Life unplugged – destination marketing campaign – social media, radio, Spotify, podcasts, ITVX, Public transport ads
- Dark Skies fringe festival – 15 businesses / 30 events: email campaign sent to 16000 people with 34% open rate
- Dark Skies festival – 59 events /33 businesses
 - 1,372,932 social media impressions (+57%)
 - 55,780 social media engagements (+46%)
 - 3,581 link clicks from social media posts (+32%)



Tourism

- Cycling events including Tour of Britain Women's stage and British Gravel championships
- 3 new gravel cycle routes launched
- New festival – Beacon for the Arts
- Partnership with Visit York to promote York as a gateway to the National Park
- Engagement with North York Moors suppliers to enhance accessibility and sustainability of tourism businesses

Monitoring

- Processing and determination of an application for an on-site deep resource investigation borehole (Woodsmith site) and related conditions discharge matters
- Provision of pre-application advice on proposals for off-site resource investigation boreholes
- Processing and determination of conditions discharge matters relating to the Lady Cross satellite shaft site
- Provision of pre-application advice relating to proposed material amendments to the existing main Woodsmith Mine planning permission
- Processing and determination of an EIA Screening request relating to proposed material amendments to the existing main Woodsmith Mine planning permission
- Undertaking of routine site monitoring activity relating to the Woodsmith Mine development
- Attendance at meetings of the Woodsmith community Liaison Forum and Traffic Management Forum
- Provision of miscellaneous advice and engagement with the public and third parties with regard to planning issues for the Woodsmith Mine development.

Geology & Archaeology

Geology – no activity this year as developing a PhD project for delivery from 2026

Archaeology - The continuation of a PhD based with the University of York. The PhD is focussed on the trods and routeways associated with the mine tunnel lidar data

Funding of a part time archaeology research officer to enhance the Historic Environment Record associated with the mine



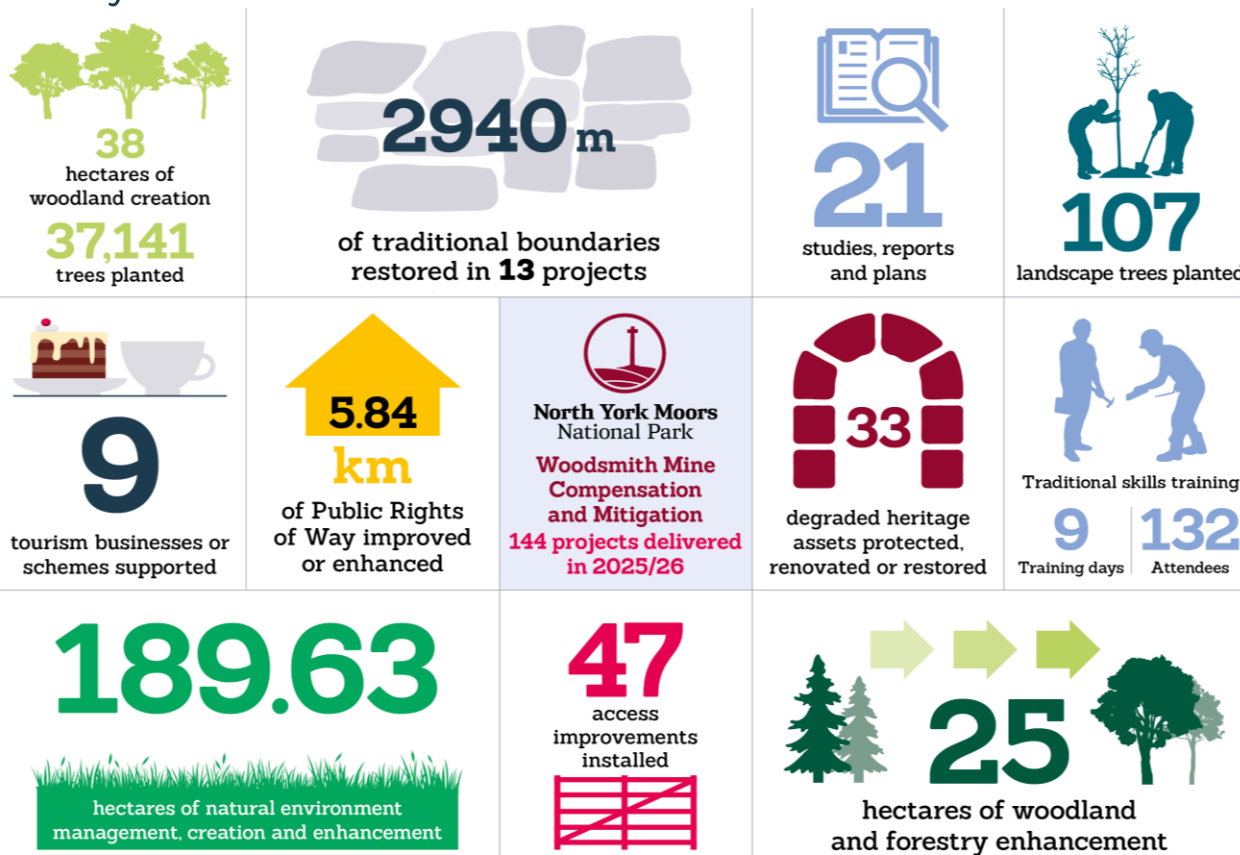
Employment

- Contribution to Scarborough West Pier Regeneration



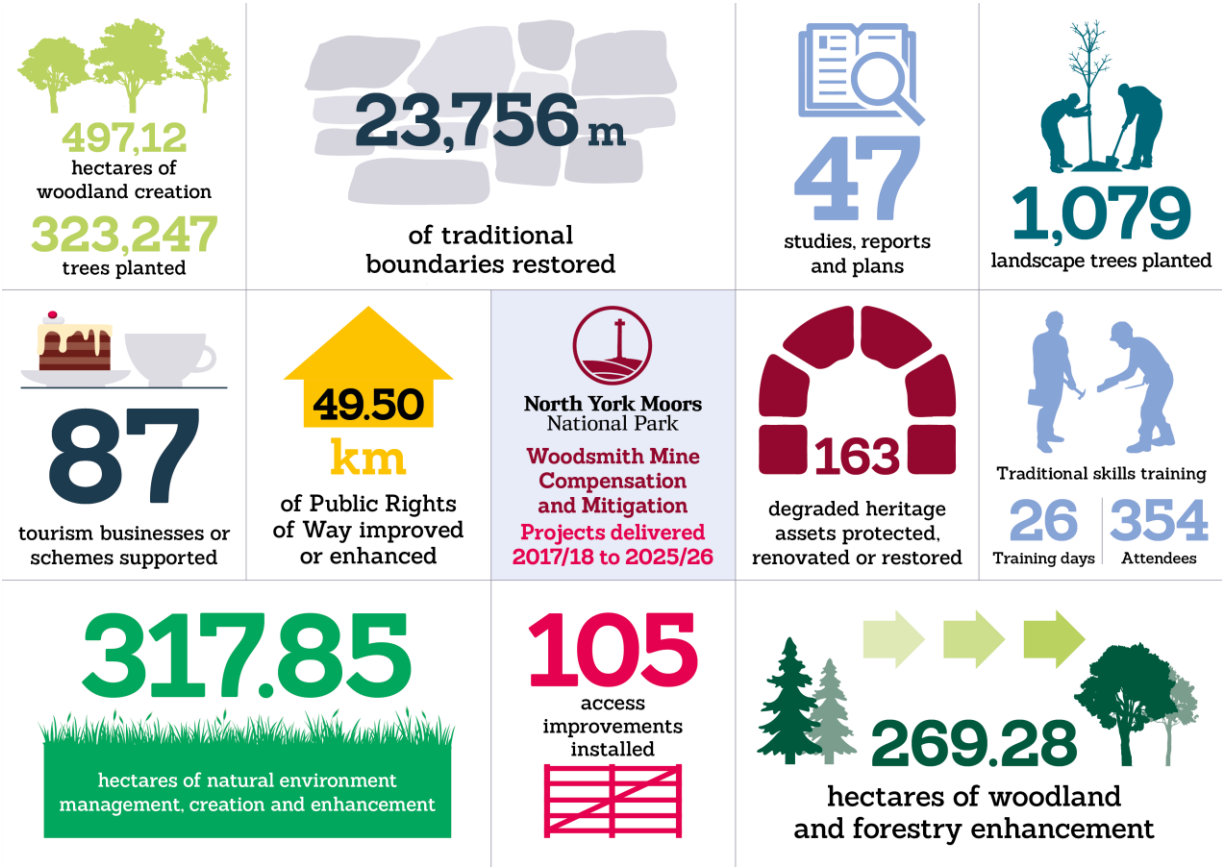
